PSAT/PLAN for 10-11th

Juniors and Sophomores will be taking the PSAT and PLAN tests on Wednesday, **October 12**. Both tests are practice and preparation for the SAT and ACT college entrance exams. The PSAT is also a National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test. Juniors were given an information booklet for the PSAT. Encourage them to take advantage of the practice test inside. The cost of the test for juniors, PSAT - \$14, and for the sophomores, the PLAN - \$12.
