LATE PICK UP FEES:

Children picked up after 6:00pm will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per minute.

DAILY CHARGE:

Daily charge for less than 1 hour per child is \$5 for After-School Childcare.

Same weekly rates apply during school holidays when Childcare remains open (Christmas, Spring Break, etc.).

Daily rates for **after-school** are available for 2 days or less per week at \$20 per day per child for K3-K5 and \$15 per day per child for Grade 01-06.

Daily rates for **Summer Daycamp** are available for 2 days or less per week at \$25 per day per child for K3-Grade 06.

SUMMER FIELD TRIPS:

Summer field trips (swimming, bowling, skating, etc.) will be charged per event. The summer calendar will list the activity along with the price.

COMMITMENT TO POLICIES and WAIVER OF LIABILITY 2019-2020

I recognize that attendance at Tabernacle Christian School is a privilege and not a right. As parents/legal guardians, I acknowledge I am expected to cooperate with and support Tabernacle and its teachers in the education and discipline of our child(ren) both in the classroom and during other related school activities. I believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of each student, as well as for the school. I give permission for my child's teacher and/or other agent of the school to make and enforce classroom regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles. Students shall forfeit the privilege of attending Tabernacle if they do not conform to the standards and way of life at the school. Tabernacle reserves the right to withdraw a student at any time that the student, in the opinion and sole discretion of the school's Administration, does not conform to the spirit of Tabernacle. I also understand that in event of withdrawal or dismissal, all financial obligations must be paid before any records or grades are released. I further recognize that Tabernacle Christian School prohibits the refund of registration fees.

I understand that Bible reading, songs, and prayer will be offered as a daily part of teaching in each classroom. Weekly, monthly, and quarterly chapel programs will be offered. Tabernacle Christian School strongly encourages our school families to be involved in their local churches. This provides an example to the children of the priority of growing, of worshipping, and of ministering for the glory of God.

I understand that the Administration of Tabernacle Christian School reserves the right to set dress code policies for all students attending school or school related activities. I pledge my cooperation with this dress code set forth in the Parent-Student Handbook. I also recognize that due to the fads and a wide variety of recent trends, the Administration reserves the right to make decisions regarding what is appropriate, modest, and neat.

In the event that a Tabernacle Christian School photographer or videographer takes a picture with my child in it, either individually or in a group, I give permission for my child's picture to be used in future brochures, videos, social media, or other publications of Tabernacle Christian School or its agents.

I give permission for my child, whose name is set forth below, to take part in all activities, including without limitation, transportation to and from events, sports activities on campus and away, and school-sponsored trips away from the school campus. I indemnify and hold harmless Tabernacle Christian School, Gardendale Baptist Tabernacle, its affiliates, employees, and agents from and against any claims, demands, causes of action, liability, medical payments, costs, and attorneys' fees resulting from or arising out of the participation by my child in the above-mentioned activities. I understand Tabernacle Christian School does not provide medical insurance for my child and that I will be solely responsible for any medical expenses or other liabilities incurred.

I understand that should any of my essential personal information change, it is my responsibility to have that information updated with the school.

This Commitment to Policies and Waiver of Liability shall remain in effect for as long as my child listed (or others to be enrolled) attends Tabernacle Christian School, whether it be in Childcare, Elementary, High School, or Summer School. Any reference herein to "child" shall include and refer to all of the children listed, or others to be enrolled in the future.

FINANCIAL POLICIES Summer 2020

REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fees are non-refundable and are due at the time of enrollment. Registration for Summer Daycamp is \$50/student for Kindergarten students and \$60/student for Elementary students.

TUITION

Summer Daycamp tuition is due at the beginning of each week. Tuition must remain current in order to attend Summer Daycamp each week.

OTHER FEES

Each summer field trip will have an associated cost. These fees may be added to your weekly costs.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Will I receive a late fee when tuition is not received by the tenth of the month? A \$20.00 late fee is assessed when tuition is past due. The school operates and stays current with all financial obligations when tuition is paid in a timely manner.

What happens when tuition has not been paid for two consecutive months? Unfortunately, it will affect class attendance for students. We regularly send out late notices by the student and through the mail. It is not our intention to embarrass any student because of late payments, but it is important that the parent communicate with the financial office about the account.

Does TCS accept postdated checks? No

What happens if a check bounces (insufficient funds)? A \$20 fee per check will be charged for insufficient checks. The check will be redeposited. Two returned checks necessitate payment by money order or cash for the remainder of the school year. The financial office reserves the right to call the banking institution to verify that the check has sufficient funds, and, if necessary, cash the check at the bank.

As parents/legal guardians, we pledge to give our support to Tabernacle Christian School in the financial policies listed and agree to abide thereby to these policies and those set forth in the Parent-Student Handbook. We fully agree to fulfill our financial obligations at Tabernacle Christian School.
